Registered students will be provided a smaller window of time for their audition (communicated via email the week prior). Students will come in a small group and sing through the audition song and perform the dance.

Sometimes the directing team needs to see a bit more before making the final casting decisions. Some students will be invited to callbacks and be asked to sing and read more material from the show. Callback lists will be emailed out after auditions. The Cast List will be communicated via email no later than Monday, February 26!

Tuesday, February 27 - 5 - 6pm Parent & Cast Meeting

All cast members and their parents are invited to join us for an informational meeting at 5pm. We will talk all things SIJ MUSICAL prior to the first cast rehearsal. Rehearsal will commence immediately following the meeting, with pick-up at 7:30pm.



Rehearsals will take place Tuesdays from 5 - 7:30pm, and Wednesdays & Fridays from 3:15 - 5pm. The rehearsal schedule will be broken down, meaning the full cast may not be called to each rehearsal, or for the full duration of each rehearsal. The breakdown of the rehearsal schedule will be available at the initial meeting on February 27. All regular rehearsals will take place at SIJ. Tech Week & Performances will take place at Montini High School.

Program Expectations:

Attendance is required at all rehearsals and performances that are listed on the initial calendar distributed on or before the first day of rehearsal. A limited number of approved conflicts will be accepted for each student. Conflict dates must be detailed on the student's audition form!

Stage Crew:

Students in 4th - 8th grade who are interested in the work that goes on behind the scenes are welcome to sign up for Stage Crew. The crew program will provide students with experience in sets & props, costumes, management, lights & sound, and more! Stage Crew will meet on select rehearsal dates (TBD).

Parent Volunteer Opportunities:

Like any amazing school program, we love to extend the opportunity to participate beyond the students and invite the parents to take an active role in shaping this experience! Parent volunteer opportunities in a variety of capacities will be available throughout the program. There is no requirement to volunteer - we welcome as little or as much volunteering that you would like to and are available to contribute.





Registration opens Wednesday, January 10!

Students in Grades 4 - 8 are eligible to participate in this year's spring musical for cast, and Students in Grades 4 - 8 are eligible to participate for crew.

Students will pay a program fee of \$400 for cast, and \$250 for crew. The program fee will cover all materials, rehearsal and performance participation, a show shirt, and costuming for cast. Please note that some costuming pieces (e.g. - undergarments, shoes, base costume items) will be expected to be provided by the student. Production mementos such as Professional Photography, Video Recordings, and Program Ads are optional additional purchases not included in tuition. The Cast Party will also be an additional cost per guest attending, and will be open to all cast & crew members as well as their family members.
